(Small Business Wage Subsidy [SBWS] Program)

April 17, 2020

#### Gentlemen/Mesdames,

Please be informed that the government has launched the **Small Business Wage Subsidy** (**SBWS**) **Program**, in an effort to help mitigate the impact of the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in Luzon. Under the SBWS, the government, through the Social Security System (SSS), will provide a wage subsidy of between Five Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\_5,000.00) to Eight Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\_8,000.00), per month, per eligible employee.

To help you better understand the program, we have prepared the following Q&A, for your appreciation and guidance:

### 1. Q: What businesses are eligible for the SBWS?

A: Only **small businesses**, i.e., must not be in the BIR's Large Taxpayer Service (LTS) List, which are forced to **stop operations** (for non-essentials) and are allowed to **operate a skeleton force** (for essentials) can apply for employees who are **not able to work and did not get paid during the ECQ**.

### 2. Q: Is there a priority among small businesses?

A: Yes, those small businesses that are duly registered with the BIR and the SSS and compliant with their tax obligations and payment of contributions, respectively, for the past three (3) years up to January 2020, will be prioritized.

#### 3. Q: Is the SBWS available to all employees?

A: No only the employees who meet the following criteria are eligible for the SBWS:

- i. Must be an employee of an eligible small business;
- ii. Must be employed and active as of March 1, 2020, but unable to work due to ECQ;
- iii. Did not get paid, for at least two (2) weeks, during the temporary closure or suspension of work, in accordance with Labor Advisory No. 1, S. 2020;

- iv. Can be of any employment status (regular, probationary, seasonal, project-based, fixed-term); and
- v. Must be certified by the employer as having met all the above criteria.

#### 4. Q: Who are not entitled to the SBWS?

A: The following employees are not eligible:

- i. Working from home or part of the skeleton force;
- ii. On leave for the entire duration of the ECQ, with or without pay;
- iii. Already a recipient of SSS unemployment benefits;
- iv. Those who have settled or pending SSS final claims (funeral, retirement, death and total disability); and
- v. Those who have received a subsidy from the Department of Labor and Employment under the COVID-19 Adjustment Measures Program (CAMP), but only with respect to the first month of the SBWS.

### 5. Q: What are the conditions to avail of the program?

A: Small businesses must maintain the employment status of all eligible employees before the ECQ and throughout the SBWS period, and the employees cannot resign during the ECQ. Non-compliance with these conditions will result in the employer refunding to the government the wage subsidy amount.

### 6. Q: How much is the subsidy amount?

A: The amount of subsidy varies, depending on the prevailing minimum wage in the region where the affected employees are working. For those working in NCR, Region III and Region IV-A (CALABARZON), the wage subsidy will be Eight Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\$8,000.00) per month.

#### 7. Q: What are the relevant dates under the SBWS?

A: Applications must be filed with the SSS from April 16, 2020 to April 30, 2020, with the first tranche of payout between May 1, 2020 to May 15, 2020 and the second tranche between May 16, 2020 to May 31, 2020.

### 8. Q: What are the modes of payment for the wage subsidy?

A: The wage subsidy will be paid through either of the following:

- i. Withdrawal via employee's SSS UMID cards enrolled as ATM;
- ii. Withdrawal from employer's bank account for PESOnet participating banks;
- iii. Employee's UnionBank Quick Card (partnership with SSS);



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iv. Employee's e-Wallet: Pay Maya

v. Cash pick-up through remittance transfer companies

### 9. Q: How is the application process commenced?

A: There is a two-fold process to the application, with the employer first checking its eligibility with the BIR (<a href="www.bir.gov.ph">www.bir.gov.ph</a>), and once eligible, to proceed to its My.SSS account in SSS (<a href="www.sss.gov.ph">www.sss.gov.ph</a>) to continue with the application. For a step-by-step breakdown of the entire process, you may refer to the attachments¹ to this O&A.

### For employers:

How do we determine if an employer is included in the pre-qualified list of the SBWS?




- Using your web browser, go to the BIR website (www.bir.gov.ph). Ensure that you have a stable internet connection.
- Click on the **SBWS icon** found on the BIR homepage. This will take you to the SBWS program query homepage.












STEP 3: Enter the 9-digit TIN in the Search field. Ensure that your TIN is valid and owned by you. BIR recommends that you check your Certificate of Registration to ensure the accuracy of information. After encoding the TIN, click on the "Search" button.











**IF YOU ARE QUALIFIED,** a green prompt will pop up.


If you are a corporation, the details that will show are your registered name or business name and passcode. Copy the passcode.











**IF YOU ARE QUALIFIED,** a green prompt will pop up.

If you are a sole proprietorship, the details that will show are your registered name or business name and passcode. Copy the passcode.






# Small Business Wage Subsidy (SBWS) Program PROCEDURE FOR EMPLOYERS

Eligible employers shall apply for the SBWS in the SSS website through their My.SSS accounts. SSS will accept applications from April 16 to April 30, 2020. Procedures are as follows:


1. EMPLOYER LOG-IN

The employer shall log-in to My.SSS account in the SSS website to initiate the application.




2. SMALL BUSINESS WAGE SUBSIDY MENU

Employer clicks the SBWS Menu Tab




### **ENCODE PASSCODE AND TAX IDENTIFICATION**



The employer enters the alphanumeric Passcode as shown in the BIR website.

The employer then provides his Tax Identification number (TIN), and clicks "Proceed" to enter the application portal.

### OUALIFIED EMPLOYEES FOR CONFIRMATION



Upon successful login, SSS shall display the list of employees in the SBWS Module in the employer's My.SSS account. The employer then selects the eligible employees by ticking the boxes beside their SS

Eligible employees are those that meet all of the following criteria:

- Must be actively employed as of March 1, 2020 but unable to work due to the ECQ Did not get paid by their employer for at least two weeks during the temporary closure or suspension of work in accordance with Labor Advisory No. 1, Series of 2020
- Can be of any contract status (e.g., regular, probationary, regular seasonal, project-based, fixed-term)

#### The following employees are not eligible

- Those working from home or part of the skeleton force
- Those on leave for the entire duration of the ECQ, whether with or without pay

On the right hand side, the employer checks whether or not the employee is a CAMP beneficiary.


If an employee is not in the SSS list, it means that the employee is not yet registered with the My.SSS facility, or that there is lacking information in their My.SSS account.

After selecting the eligible employees, the employer shall enter the TIN of each employee.

Once all eligible employees have been checked, the employer should click on "Employer Undertaking" link to access the terms and conditions. He shall then tick the box to signify that he has read and agrees to the Employer's Undertaking.

#### **EMPLOYER'S UNDERTAKING**




The employer must certify certain conditions in the Employer's Undertaking, such as:

- All information contained in the application is true, accurate, and complete
- All employees are apprised of the nature of the application and notified those qualified, and the reasons for the disqualification of others
- All qualified employees are informed of the purpose of sharing their personal and/or sensitive personal information with SSS, DOF and BIR, and that they give their full consent thereto.

The employer must submit any of the listed supporting documents certifying the employees' work and pay status (Employer Certification templates are available for downloading). These may be submitted via email to <a href="mailto:SBWSCertifications@sss.gov.ph">SBWSCertifications@sss.gov.ph</a> or to the nearest SSS Branch.



### **CONFIRMATION PAGE FOR QUALIFIED EMPLOYEES**




The SSS automated system shall check and validate the following:

- Employee has neither pending nor settled SSS Unemployment Benefit Claim due to COVID-19 related reasons,
- Employee is not a DOLE CAMP beneficiary, and
- Employee has neither pending nor settled SSS final benefit claim (funeral, retirement, death, and total disability).



SSS informs the employer of employees who are qualified and those disqualified and the reason.

**8.** EMAIL NOTIFICATIONS




SSS shall notify the eligible employees through email that their employer has confirmed their qualification to the SBWS Program and provides the details when the subsidy shall be credited to their bank accounts or available for disbursement through remittance agents.

SSS shall disburse the wage subsidy through the following payment channels:

- SSS UMID card enrolled as ATM;
- PESOnet participating banks;
- Union Bank Quick Card;
- Electronic wallets such as PayMaya; or
- · Cash pick-up through remittance partner agents.

### **OUALIFIED EMPLOYEES LACKING CREDENTIALS**




SSS also informs the employer of employees who are qualified but lacking credentials, such as:

- 1. If the employee is not registered in My.SSS
- 2. If the employee has no bank account
- 3. If the employee has no registered bank account in his My.SSS account.

For unsuccessful credits due to invalid bank accounts, SSS shall notify the employees to change the invalid bank accounts within five (5) banking days in the Bank Enrollment Module of the My.SSS facility. A notice shall also be sent to the employer to advise the employees to enroll correctly their bank/payment accounts.



### **DISQUALIFIED EMPLOYEES**



Employees may also be disqualified if they have an existing Unemployment Benefit Claim due to COVID-19 related reasons or a settled/in-process final benefit claim (e.g., death, funeral, total disability, or retirement).

### **CONFIRMED EMPLOYEES**



SSS shall inform the employer of the employees successfully confirmed in the SBWS Module. A notice shall also be sent to the qualified employee.
